How to Exhibit

The 2023 Public Health Law Conference will be held at the Renaissance Depot Hotel in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Only 11 tabletop spaces are available to ensure optimal visibility for all exhibitors and to create a relaxed, open space that encourages attendees to gather to visit with exhibitors and colleagues.

The exhibition space will be in the atrium directly outside the main ballroom. Each exhibitor will have a high-top café style table and two tall chairs with room to display their organization's signage and other materials. Center tables in the exhibition space will serve as conversation tables for attendees. The opening celebration reception will take place in the exhibition space and will include food and beverages.
